So we are here today to do an amendment to the resolution that was passed last year for us to go after the initial grant through Sullivan Renaissance who we won the grant through in the amount of \$350,000.00. He also thanked those in the Town of Thompson for assisting us the their free grant writing services through the Supervisor's Personal Secretary, Patrice, who has now retired and moved out of the area. Mayor Nikolados made the Board and Public aware that \$100,000.00 to get the work started and the rest will be refunded once the project is completed.
